2026 Tigers Youth Cheer Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct and Attendance Policy

As a parent in the Tigers Youth Cheer Organization, you agree to abide by and follow the rules and policies listed below. Failure to adhere to these guidelines and policies will result in potential suspension from a game, entire season, or competition(s). Also, if your child does not follow these same guidelines and policies they will potentially face removal from team and/or competition privileges.

1. I will adhere to the Union Endicott ZERO TOLERANCE policy. I will never be under the influence of or possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, or weapons of any kind at practices, games, and competitions.
2. I understand that the use of foul language towards anyone (coaches, teammates, officials, board members, opponents, and spectators) will not be tolerated. I will not engage in any language or actions with the intent to initiate, intimidate, or hurt any athlete (football and cheer), coach, official, board member, or spectator. These acts shall be considered harassment and will result in immediate removal from the event, and potentially lead to further consequences for the remainder of the season.
3. Cheerleaders are expected to demonstrate respect and sportsmanship at all times. This includes refraining from any form of bullying, intimidation, or disrespect toward fellow athletes, coaches, or others—whether during games, practices, or on social media. During practices, cheerleaders must avoid engaging in behaviors that are unsafe, disruptive, or detrimental to the team's focus and unity.
4. I will support the coaches and allow them to do their job by coaching my child and other players during games, practices, and competitions. I will not openly question or confront coaches before, during, or after a game, competition or practice. I will take the time to speak with coaches about any concerns calmly, privately, and at an agreed upon time and place.
5. I will not post to any social media site with the intent to intimidate, hurt, or humiliate any player (football and cheer), coach, board member, official, spectator, or the Tigers Youth Football and Cheer league in general. The posting of negative, demeaning, or derogatory comments will not be tolerated. These acts shall be considered harassment and may result in the immediate removal of your child from the team and/or competitions. As a parent, I understand that I am accountable for the actions of my child on social media, and will do my due diligence to oversee and prevent any of these issues from occurring on their own accounts.
6. I will inform the coach of any physical disability, illness, or injury that may affect the safety of my child and the safety of others.
7. Cheerleading uniforms will not be worn outside of games or competition. **Uniforms cannot be worn to school.** Parents will be responsible for repairing or replacing any damage to uniforms. Failure to return your uniform at the end of the season will forfeit your child's status as a returner for the following season.

Attendance Policy:

1. I will drop off and pick up my child at practices and games in a timely manner. If your child has to miss a practice or you are going to have difficulties with drop/off or pick up you will reach out to the coach immediately.
2. In order to fully prepare these teams to be successful at competition, we need cheerleaders to be at practices and games. Unexcused absences will NOT be tolerated. More than 2 unexcused absences may result in your child losing their ability to participate in competitions.
 - a. Some examples of unexcused absences - Vacations that are not during the summer (ones that happen after school starts), attending other sporting games and practices, feeling tired, "not in the mood", etc.
 - b. If you have an absence and are unsure of its status, please reach out to the coach to see if it counts as excused or unexcused.
3. If you have an excused absence please let your coach know ASAP. You cannot miss practice and not inform your coach. Coaches need to know who will be at practice in order to plan accordingly.
 - a. Some examples of excused absences - sick, medical surgeries, religious events, school academic events (concert, awards ceremony, etc), important family events (weddings, funerals, etc.)
 - b. If your child is very sick, please keep them home. The start of the school year brings a lot of sniffles and colds. If you feel their sickness is not too horrible, then you can send them to practice. If they have a gastro bug, fever, or some sort of contagious illness (strep, covid, flu, etc) please keep them home.

I realize if I violate the Tigers Youth Cheer Code of Conduct and Attendance Policy I may be subject to disciplinary action that could include one of more, but not limited to the following:

1. Parental game or season suspension.
2. Parental competition suspension.
3. Parental suspension from all future Tigers Youth Football and Cheer games, practices, competitions and events.
4. Athlete suspension from a part/full game(s) or competition(s).
5. Athlete removal from the team.
6. Athlete suspension from all future Tigers Youth Cheer squads.
